This essential, if abbreviated, show spans the great Ukrainian photographer's four-decade career. In the nineties, Mikhailov patrolled the streets after the collapse of the Soviet Union, recording the down-and-out with a mixture of outrage, despair, and pitch-black humor. A sequence of a hundred and thirty murky, panoramic prints—all tinted a washy cyanotype blue—rings one room here with scenes of what looks like the drunken, exhausted end of the world. A satirical series of the photographer and his friends acting posh and careless at a seaside spa is like a comic opera with plenty of bite. Through Feb. 8.
