★ **Boris Mikhailov: 'Four Decades'** (closes on Saturday) The photographer Boris Mikhailov, born in Ukraine in 1938, has become widely known in late career for his wry and wrenching pictures of post-Soviet life. This mini-survey explores some of the less confrontational but equally challenging work Mr. Mikhailov made before the collapse of the Soviet Union. It's dominated by the series "At Dusk," which finds Mr. Mikhailov playing street photographer in his hometown, Kharkov, from 1990 to 1993, during the early stages of Ukraine's post-Soviet transition. With Ukraine embroiled in political turmoil, these photos give us a deeply human perspective on its street culture.
